NCHS upset bid falls short in 31-21 loss to Byrd

SHREVEPORT, La. - The Natchitoches Central Chiefs pushed the Byrd Yellow Jackets before falling, 31-21, Friday night on the road in district 1-5A at Lee Hedges Stadium in Shreveport.

The Chiefs (1-6, 0-5 in district 1-5A) fell behind 7-0 early in the first quarter before battling back. Midway through the opening quarter, KJ Newton caught a pass from Owen Smith for a 52-yard touchdown pass from Owen Smith tying the game at 7-7.
