

Chiefs, Lady Chiefs dominate during first day of City of Lights Tournament

NATCHITOCHEs, La. - The Natchitoches Central Chiefs and Lady Chiefs picked up lopsided wins during day one of the City of Lights Tournament at NCHS with the Lady Chiefs beating Rosepine, 47-14, and the Chiefs cruising past Loyola, 84-49.

The Lady Chiefs (4-1) got 11 points from Annalise Newton and 10 points from Katlynn Wiggins rolling to the win. The Lady Chiefs also defeated Winnfield earlier in the day 46-13 as Akeelah Wade led NCHS with 17 points while Wiggins had 12.

In the final game of the day, the Chiefs (1-0) opened their season in style with the blowout win. Sophomore Khaelyb Creighton and senior Ja'Dell Demery scored 21 points each to lead the way while senior Jaden Braden added 20. Demery also tore down 12 rebounds.

The Chiefs scored a robust 60 points in the paint while also putting up 41 points off turnovers.

The Lady Chiefs will play Tuesday night at the Teepee at approximately 7 p.m. against Oakdale while the Chiefs will face off against Ringgold immediately following the Lady Chiefs.
