Lady Chiefs win 15th straight, Chiefs dominate in doubleheader sweep of Anacoco

NATCHITOCHES, La. - The Natchitoches Central Chiefs and Lady Chiefs defeated the Anacoco Indians Tuesday night at NCHS in non-district basketball action with the Lady Chiefs winning, 55-43, and the Chiefs crushed the Indians 76-27.

The Lady Chiefs (17-1) notched their 15th straight win as Jordan McDaniel led NCHS with 17 points and seven rebounds while Annalise Newton and Akeelah Wade both had 15 points to push NCHS past the Lady Indians (11-8).

The Chiefs (12-4) had no trouble in the second half of the doubleheader as they Ja'Dell Demery led the way with 23 points and 11 rebounds while Jaden Braden had 18 points. The Chiefs drilled 10 three-pointers (10-for-20) while shooting 57 percent on 28-for-53 shooting.

The Indians (9-14) shot just 9-for-23 from the field while committing 30 turnovers.

Next up, the Chiefs and Lady Chiefs will face Southwood Friday night on the road in Shreveport weather permitting. Shreveport is facing a 65 percent chance of rain and snow Friday with a high of 39 degrees and a low of 28.
