

Lady Tigers head to New Orleans for first round playoff game against McGehee

NATCHITOCHES, La. - The district 1-division V champion St. Mary's Lady Tigers' volleyball team will enter the playoffs as the 28th- seed and will take on the fifth-ranked Louis McGehee Lady Hawks out of New Orleans in the first round of the Division V playoffs at time to be announced.

The Lady Tigers (8-14, 4-0 in district 1-division V) wrapped up the regular with a win over Providence Christian Academy last Thursday.

St. Mary's enters the playoffs battle tested as nine of its 14 losses are against Division I and Division II teams.

The Lady Tigers' roster includes 11 players; Tyonnah Burton, Camille Procell, Rayanna Norsworthy, Addison Ivy, Cailah Bush, Joelee Savell, Mary Hannah Churchman, Adelle Williams, Peyton Faucheaux, Emme Errington and Lily Boyd.

McGehee (18-8, 3-1 in district 9-division V) enters the postseason winners of six of its last seven matches. The Lady Hawks have had a ton of historical success having advanced to the quarterfinals nine years in a row dating back to 2015 including winning the Division V state title back in 2016.

The winner of the match will face the winner of 12th-ranked Ascension Episcopal (15-14) and 21st-ranked Northeast (13-7) in the second round at a date and time TBA.
