

Chiefs tie, Lady Chiefs fall to North DeSoto

STONEWALL, La. - The Natchitoches Central Chiefs and Lady Chiefs faced the North DeSoto Griffins Thursday night on the road in non-district soccer action with the Lady Chiefs falling 6-2 and the Chiefs tying 1-1.

The Lady Chiefs (3-8) got goals from senior Anna Hobart in the 65th minute and Claire Perritt in the 78th while junior Amelia Willis assisted on both goals. North DeSoto (11-6-3) however jumped out to a 3-0 first half lead with goals in the fourth, 32nd and 35th minute and never looked back.

The Chiefs (3-6-3) rallied back from 3-1 down to the Griffins (5-9-2) 3-3. NCHS's Chad Johnson scored the Chiefs' first goal in the fourth minute on an assist from Eli Hypes.

The Chiefs were able to tie the game after falling behind 3-1 in the second half as Mateo Restrepo scored in the 55th minute and Amsden Pasch tied the game in the 66th minute on an assist from Bryce Smith.
