Lady Gators roll past Red River, Gators fall to Bulldogs

CAMPTI, La. - The Lakeview Gators and Lady Gators split a doubleheader with the Red River Bulldogs and Lady Bulldogs Saturday night at LHS as the Lady Gators won, 61-25, while the Gators were defeated, 50-39.

The Lady Gators (14-4) took control right out of the gate as they led 18-4 at the end of the first quarter before exploding to a 37-11 halftime lead on their way to the win over the Lady Bulldogs (6-10).

Lakeview was led by Timberlyn Washington with 20 points while Nahaje Davis added 12 to aid the Lady Gators. The victory was the 10th straight for the Lady Gators over Red River with their last loss coming to the Lady Bulldogs on Feb. 14, 2020.

The second half of the doubleheader was much more competitive. The Bulldogs had lost four in a row and five of the last six to the Gators coming into the game.

Despite the Gators (12-4) falling behind 8-0 to start the game, they weathered the early storm and trailed 28-17 at halftime.

In third quarter, the Gators began to inch their way back into the game as they had cut the Bulldogs' lead to 39-35 going to the fourth quarter. The Gators continued to nip at the Bulldogs' heels as they trailed 42-37 with under three minutes to go. However, the Bulldogs (10-3) ended the game on an 8-2 run to keep LHS at arm's length to leave the jam-packed Swamp with a victory.

The Gators were led by Jamarcus Reliford with 15 points while Bobby Reliford added eight to pace Lakeview.

Next up, The Gators and Lady Gators will hit the road to face Ringgold in non-district action Tuesday night beginning at 6 p.m. with the girls' game.
