

Gators win third straight, roll past Ringgold 15-0

CAMPTI, La. - The Lakeview Gators' baseball team won its third straight game Tuesday afternoon with a 15-0 win over the Ringgold Redskins at home.

The Gators (3-1) took advantage of four errors by the Redskins as every player in the lineup scored at least once for Lakeview. The Gators scored two runs in the first, 11 in the second and two in the third.

Lakeview sent 17 batters to the plate in the 11-run second inning which featured four hits, three walks while six Gators' hitters were hit by a pitch.

Austin Cherry, Cruz Bandaries, Tyler Ritchie, Loden Riddle, Tristan Lee-Johnson and Gavin Spears all had one hit for the Gators.

Ritchie was perfect on the mound not allowing a baserunner in three innings and struck out nine.
