

**Guillet dominates as Chiefs win 7-3 over Northwood-Shreveport**

**SHREVEPORT, La.** - Senior Adam Guillet didn't allow a hit and struck out 10 batters in four innings setting a tone for the Natchitoches Central Chiefs' baseball team in Saturday's 7-3 win over the Northwood-Shreveport Falcons on the road.

The Chiefs (5-1) jumped out to a 4-0 lead as senior Yancy Spillman Jr. drilled a two-run single in the first inning to make it 2-0. In the third, senior Andrew Odom helped the Chiefs' cause with another two-run single. That was more than enough for Guillet, the Louisiana Tech signee, who faced just 15 batters in four innings.

After an unearned run in the third, the Chiefs scored two runs in the fifth to make it 6-1 as Owen Smith stole third and scored on an error. Moments later, Odom singled home a run.

Smith and Odom both finished with three hits each while Spillman had three RBIS. Senior Kyron Payne had two hits to aid the Chiefs' 10-hit attack.

Senior Harper Marcotte came on in relief to get the save as the Chiefs' left-hander threw 1 2/3 innings and allowed just one hit and struck out two.

Coming up next, the Chiefs will play Tuesday on the road against Winnfield at 6:30 p.m.
