

Chiefs crush Loyola 11-1 to remain undefeated

SHREVEPORT, La. - The Natchitoches Central Chiefs' baseball team remained undefeated with a five-inning 11-1 win over the Loyola Prep Flyers Thursday afternoon in the Northwood-Shreveport Tournament.

The Chiefs (4-0) scored in every inning and had eight out of nine starters record at least one hit. NCHS scored two runs in the first inning, one in the second, one in the third, four in the fourth and three in the fifth to cruise past the Flyers (3-1).

The Chiefs were led by Titus William with three hits while Kyron Payne and Brock Laird had two each to lead the 12-hit attack for Natchitoches Central.

Junior Owen Smith picked up the win on the mound for NCHS pitching four innings, allowing two hits, one run, one earned, two walks and struck out four.

Next up, the Chiefs will face the Benton Tigers (5-0) Friday at 3 p.m. in Day 2 of the Northwood-Shreveport Tournament.
