

Gators and Lady Gators remain hot with doubleheader sweep of Montgomery

CAMPTI, La. - The Lakeview Gators and Lady Gators swept a doubleheader against the Montgomery Tigers and Lady Tigers Friday night in district 3-1A basketball competition with the Lady Gators winning 50-35 and the Gators 62-51.

The second-ranked Lady Gators (20-4, 4-0 in 3-1A) jumped out to a 21-9 halftime lead and maintained a double digit lead all night. The Lady Gators, winners of 12 straight, were led by Da'zya Johnson with 19 points while Timberlyn Washington added 15 to get the win over the Lady Tigers (10-10, 2-1 in 3-1A)

The fourth-ranked Gators (17-4, 4-0 in 3-1A) got off to a hot start as they scored 24 points in the first quarter to lead to 24-15. However, the Tigers (9-11, 2-1 in 3-1A) rallied back as LHS led 31-30 at halftime.

In the third quarter, the Gators dominated as they outscored Montgomery 17-6 to take a 48-46 lead to hold off the Tigers for their eighth win in nine games.

The Gators had four players in double figures led by Bobby Reliford and Daylon Telsee with 12 points each. BJ Jones and Jamarcus Reliford had 10 points to aid the Gators.

Coming up, Lakeview will face St. Mary's Tuesday night on the road beginning at 6 p.m. as district play continues.
