

Chiefs' get gem from Lindsey in 9-0 win over Menard

ALEXANDRIA, La. - Alabama signee Ross Lindsey was perfect for the Natchitoches Central Chiefs' baseball team as he didn't allow a baserunner in four innings in Thursday's 9-0 win over Menard in the Tioga Tournament.

The Chiefs (6-2) had 12 hits led by Owen Smith with three. Yancy Spillman and Titus Williams both had two hits to pace the offensive attack. Brock Laird, Dillon Braxton, Andrew Odom, Adam Guillet and Max Wardell all had one hit for the Chiefs.

The Chiefs scored three in the first, one in the third and five in the fifth as they dominated the entire game.

Lindsey faced the minimum of 12 batters in four innings while striking out and eight. The senior also threw 54 pitches with 37 of them being strikes. Kaiden Vallery and Andrew Odom pitched the final three innings allowing just two hits combined and four strikeouts.

Next up, the Chiefs will play Friday at 6 p.m. on the road against the Tioga Indians.
