

Terrell, Robinson lead NCHS to route of Evangel 13-3

SHREVEPORT, La. - Senior Sydney Terrell pitched a complete game and drove in six runs for the Natchitoches Central Lady Chiefs in a 13-3 route of the Evangel Christian Academy Lady Eagles Tuesday at Evangel in district 1-5A softball action.

The Lady Chiefs (7-13, 3-2 in 1-5A) struck with an early run in the top of the first as junior Ehren Guidroz singled to left to score Maggie Massia.

After ECA (8-12, 1-4 in 1-5A) scored two runs in the bottom of the first, the Lady Chiefs quickly responded as they scored four in the top of the second. Morgan Robinson dropped a single to left scoring Skylar Braxton. Two batters later, Terrell drove a three-run double off the center field wall to make it 5-2 NCHS.

In the third, the Lady Chiefs continued to pour it on. Bre Hale doubled to center field to score Braxton before Massia singled in Hale making it 7-2. Later in the inning, Terrell lined a two-run single center scoring Massia and Lila Robertson to make it 9-2.

In the fifth inning, Robinson smashed a solo homerun to left field to push it to 10-3 NCHS. The Lady Chiefs added three more in the seventh as Terrell singled home her sixth RBI of the game before Guidroz ripped a two-run single to center to round out the scoring.

NCHS finished with 11 hits led by Robinson and Terrell with three each while Guidroz had two. Robinson and Massia both scored three runs to set the pace for the Lady Chiefs.

Terrell threw all seven innings allowing nine hits, two earned runs, three walks and eight strikeouts.

Next up, NCHS will face Byrd Thursday at home at 6 p.m.
