

Chiefs win 20th game of the season, route Many 15-0

NATCHITOCHES, La. - The Natchitoches Central Chiefs won their 20th game of the season Tuesday night as they routed the Many Tigers, 15-0, at home in non-district action.

The Chiefs (20-6) finished with 14 hits as eight of their nine starters had at least one hit led by Titus Williams, Dillon Braxton and Yancy Spillman Jr with two each. Williams was 2-for-3 with three runs scored while Spillman was 2-for-2 with a run scored and two RBIs. Braxton was 2-for-4 with a run scored.

NCHS's balanced attack featured 11 different players scoring at least one run while 10 players had at least one hit.

The Chiefs scored three runs in the first as Andrew Odom ripped an RBI single to center field scoring Kaiden Vallery before Spillman lined two-run double to right field scoring Odom and Williams.

NCHS continued the offensive onslaught in the second inning scoring four more. Senior Brock Laird lined an RBI single to left before Odom hit a sacrifice fly to make it 5-0. Moments later, Williams reached on an error to score a run before Adam drew an RBI walk pushing it to 7-0.

The Chiefs finished things off in the fourth as they sent 13 batters to the plate scoring eight runs. NCHS racked up seven hits in the inning highlighted by a pair of two-run doubles by Guillet and Daygen Johnson and two-run single by Rees Williams.

Jace Hale started the game on the mound for NCHS throwing three and two-thirds innings, allowing just two hits, two walks and striking out two.

NCHS has now won eight of their last nine games as they take on the Parkway Panthers (9-12, 4-6 in 1-5A) Saturday on the road at 1 p.m.
