

Chiefs stun Glenmora in final seconds for first win

GLENMORA, La. - The Natchitoches Central Chiefs' soccer team picked up a thrilling win, 2-1, over the Glenmora Wildcats Monday night on the road.

The Chiefs (1-4-1) trailed at halftime 1-0 as the Wildcats scored in the 25th minute.

NCHS responded in the second half as Clarke Glenn scored on a penalty kick in the 58th minute. The Chiefs held strong as the game was tied at 1-1 until the final minute.

NCHS's Bryce Smith had a throw in with 30 seconds left, the ball deflected off a Glenmora defender into the net to Smith credit for the game-winning goal.

"We started out slow," said NCHS head coach Daniel Litton. "But we got really aggressive in the second half and kept the ball on their side of the field for most of the second half. There was no quit in our guys and I'm really proud of us."

The Chiefs play again Wednesday at 5 p.m. against North DeSoto.
