

Lady Chiefs win seventh straight with district win over Caddo Magnet

NATCHITOCHES, La. - The Natchitoches Central Lady Chiefs' volleyball team won their seventh straight game as it defeated Caddo Magnet 25-5, 25-6 and 25-5 Tuesday night at home.

NCHS (8-2, 3-0 in District 1-Division II) wasted no time in taking control. With senior Ellie Wilson on the service line, the Lady Chiefs went on an 11-0 run in the first set to take a 12-2 lead. Later in the set, Campbell Morrow served nine straight points to to give NCHS a 21-4 lead. Senior Tatum Kay got the kill to finish the opening set, 25-5.

The Lady Chiefs continued to dominate in the second set. They opened on a 10-2 run before senior Ayla Payne served eight straight points as NCHS roared to a 23-6 advantage. Sophomore Maggie Massia finished the set with a put away to give the Lady Chiefs a two-set lead.

In the third set, Natchitoches Central continued to dominate as Kendall Rhodes served 13 straight points as the Lady Chiefs opened up a 22-3 third set lead before picking up the win.

NCHS plays again Wednesday night on the road against Pineville at 6 p.m. as the Lady Chiefs look for their eighth straight victory.
