

Gators drop first game of the season, fall to Winnfield 68-62

CAMPTI, La. - The Lakeview Gators were handed their first loss of the season Tuesday night at home as they fell to the Winnfield Tigers, 68-62.

Lakeview (5-1) seemed to be in control led 32-24 at halftime. But the Tigers began to chip way in the second half as they outscored the Gators 15-9 in the third quarter.

However, Winnfield's Jaylon Jackson took over in the fourth quarter as he scored 17 of his game-high 30 points in the final eight minutes.

The Gators were led by Jamarcus Reliford with 23 points while Daylon Telsee had 16 points while Brandon Jones had 10 points.
