

Chiefs win third straight over Airline with 6-1 victory Thursday at home

NATCHITOCHES, La. - Senior Adam Guillet pitched six innings and allowed no earned runs as the Natchitoches Central Chiefs defeated the Airline Vikings, 6-1, Thursday night in district 1-5A baseball action at NCHS.

The Chiefs (15-5, 6-2 in 1-5A) scored three runs in the first inning as NCHS took advantage of a walk and error to score two runs while Guillet singled home the other to give the Chiefs a 3-0 lead. NCHS added a run in the second as Kyron Payne walked and later scored on a pass ball making it 4-0.

Airline (12-8, 6-2 in 1-5A) scored a run in the fourth as the Chiefs made two errors before a bunt single plated the Vikings only run.

The Chiefs scored two more runs in the fifth as Yancy Spillman Jr hit an RBI single to left before Guillet doubled home another run to make it 6-1.

That was more than enough for Guillet who allowed just four hits and walked three while striking out five in his six innings. Harper Marcotte come in relief in the seventh and retired the side in order.

The Chiefs finished with eight hits led by Guillet and Titus Williams with two.

Next up, the Chiefs will play at Captain Shreve Saturday at 1 p.m. in Shreveport in district action.
